We have had an extremely successful start to the 2022-23 school year! Due to the large volume of traffic at our school, anyone walking in the parking lot automatically creates a safety hazard. For this reason, all parents should use the car line for arrival and dismissal. Please help us ensure the safety of all by reviewing the following reminders.

Morning Arrival Reminders:

- ☐ Students should be unbuckled and have their supplies ready to get out when you reach the sidewalk.
- ☐ All parents are encouraged to use the car line to drop students off. If you need to come to the office, please park in a parking spot and not in the grass.
- ☐ If you need to come to the office, please wait for the car line to stop moving before crossing.
- ☐ Please remain in your car while in the car line. Faculty members will assist your child getting out of the car and into the building.

Afternoon Dismissal Reminders:

- ☐ All students are dismissed through the carline. Please do not come inside to have your child's name called.
- ☐ Early dismissals will not be allowed after 2:15 unless there is an emergency.
- ☐ If your child is not on the front sidewalk and has to be recalled, please pull to the blue cone at the end of the building and remain in your car. A staff member will bring your student to you.
- ☐ Please remain in your car while in the car line. If you need to buckle your student, please pull around to the parking lot near the gym to buckle.
- ☐ All cars using the back carline should enter the Siloam Baptist parking lot using the marked entrance from Hwy 81. Do not enter the line from the Siloam parking lot. You must enter the line from Hwy 81. The back car line should not form before 1:30 pm. More detailed information and a map can be found by clicking [here](#).
